**PRESENTATION:** Presentation of Champion sashes and trophies will be given at time of judging.

**PLEASE NOTE:** If a competitor chooses to compete in multiple rings, classes **WILL NOT** be held up if they clash. Judges dicression will apply.

**GROUND ENTRY:** Entry to the grounds is restricted to vehicles with floats and/or horse trucks. All other vehicles MUST park in the main car park (access from Victoria Road).

#### **DEFINITIONS:**

**Open Ring:** Open to Reg. & Un-Reg. horses. No membership requirements.

**Novice Horse Class:** Horse that has not won a first prize at ANY SHOW prior to this date.

**Novice Rider:** Rider that has not won a first prize at ANY SHOW prior to this date.

**District:** Exhibitor to be a resident of Municipality of Huon Valley or Kingborough.

Pony Club: Exhibitor to be a financial member of a Pony Club.

**Age of rider:** To be taken as at the 1st January in the year of the Show.

**Hard hats:** Riders must wear current safety standard approved helmets at all times whilst mounted.

**Measuring:** If required, EA height certificate must be produced upon request.

#### **Conditions of Showjumping Entry:**

- To compete in closed events (Classes 200-202 &204-207 any class under 1.05m) riders must be a financial member of a Jumping Tasmania branch, a Pony Club Tasmania club or Equestrian Australia.
- To compete in open events (Class 203 any class 1.05m and over) riders must be a Competition member of Equestrian Australia and horses must have a current competition licence.
- Classes will be conducted under current EA National Jumping Rules (Jan 2025)
- Formal dress as per Article 256.1.1-5 or Pony Club Uniform
- · Horses may compete in three classes, only one of which can be a Championship.
- To qualify for 'Off the Track" you must provide horse's racing name at time of entry
- Prizes as listed in schedule and ribbons to 4th place. These will be awarded at the conclusion of each class.
- The organisers have the right to alter, omit or add to the advertised programme classes, conditions and prizes if conditions on the day so require.
- No classes will be held up waiting for any competitor in any other class.

### SHOW ENTRY REGULATIONS

- 1. Closing date for entries is the 11 November. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON SHOW DAY.
- 2. The committee reverves the right to refuse or reject any entry which it considers objectionable or unworthy of exhibition.
- 3. The Judges' decision will be final.
- 4. All exhibitors must place their exhibits in the space allotted them. All exhibits, when on the Showground will be under the control of the stewards, and exhibitors and those in charge of exhibits are expected to co-operate with the stewards and carry out their wishes.
- 5. A fee of \$20 must accompany protests, which will become forfeit if in the opinion of the Committee the protest is deemed to be trivial.
- 6.If, in the opinion of the Chief Steward any exhibit or stock shall be deemed to be diseased, dangerous or objectionable, the owner of such exhibit shall immediately, upon notice to that effect, remove such exhibit from the Society's ground.
- 7. In the event of any animal breaking loose and/or causing any damage whatsoever, the owner of such animal or person having control thereof, shall indemnify the Society against all damages, costs, expenses or liabilities incurred in connection with the same. Whilst we have a significant Public Liability Insurance cover of our own, it does not necessarily protect livestock exhibitors from claims which may be made against them as a result of exhibiting their animals. It is strongly recommended that you contact your insurer to ensure your own Public Liability Insurance is extended to cover you whilst your stock is off the farm and exhibited elsewhere.
- 8. The judge has authority to re-class in all livestock sections.
- 9. Any exhibit entered in the wrong class by the exhibitor may be excluded from competition in that class, but may be permitted by the stewards to compete in its proper class.
- 10. Three or more entries must be received in any class or no second prize money will be paid. In addition to prize money, the Society will present first, second, third and fourth prize ribbons.
- 11. Prize money will not be paid until after 1pm
- 12. Championship ribbons will be awarded at the judge's discretion.
- 13. The Committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel any event, through lack of entries or any other cause whatever.
- 14. No stock may be removed from the Showground before 4 pm except with the permission of the Chief Steward.
- 15. When submitting entries, exhibitors will please quote schedule numbers and sections of their respective exhibits.
- 16. The Committee will not act as 'go-between' or undertake to sell any exhibit for the benefit of, or on behalf of, owners or exhibitors unless special arrangements have previously been made with the secretary. Nor may any exhibitor or owner conduct sales of exhibits or cause such exhibits to be removed during Show hours in such a manner as might be deemed to interfere with the Show or its functions without permission from the respective officials in charge of such exhibits.
- 17. You enter the showground and exhibit your animals knowing you do so at your own risk.

#### **EQUINE SPECIFIC:**

- 1. Stallions are **NOT** permitted on ground.
- 2. Exhibitors, their families and patrons are reminded that horse sports are dangerous activities and being around livestock can result in injury. You enter the showground and exhibit your animals knowing you do so at your own risk.
- 3. Competitors and spectators are to be respectful to each other, judges and officials. **ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
- 4. Competitors and spectators are to refrain from engaging in conversation with judges.
- **5. ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY.**
- 6. Competitors may warm up in the competition rings up to 8.30am, from 8.30am the rings will be CLOSED.
- 7. Class changes will not be accommodated on the day unless granted by the Chief Steward.
- 8. To ensure safe entry into the rings, competitors are required not to enter the ring area until the class is called.
- 9. Spectators are requested to stay on the outside of the competition area.

Failure to comply with conditions of entry may result in the forfeit of competitors entry fees.

Physical competitions and activities, Events and use of the Suppliers' facilities are all dangerous recreational activities. This document is a risk warning for the purpose of Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act TAS 2002. This risk warning is given by or on behalf of the Suppliers.

This document acts as an exclusion of liability under Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act (TAS) 2002 if the services supplied by the Suppliers are supplied without reasonable care and skill.

#### Section B - Participant's acknowledgements

By signing this document I acknowledge that:

- 1. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a recreational service for the purposes of section 139A of the Australian Competition and Consumer Act (Cth) 2010 and a recreational activity for the purposes of Division 5 of the Civil Liability Act (TAS) 2002.
- 2. I participate in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities at my own risk.
- 3. Participation in the Event and/or use of the Suppliers' facilities is a hazardous activity and involves a significant risk of physical harm and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me and others.

- 9. In handling animals, there is a risk of suffering injury including injuries caused by the animals.
- 10. I am responsible for ensuring that I have and will wear equipment suitable for my safety in my participation of the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.
- 11. I am responsible for the condition of any tools and equipment and ensuring that they are appropriate for the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities.

- 12. I use the Suppliers' facilities, including for the Event entirely at my own risk, as I find them and with the prior acceptance of the risk of possible danger to me, both obvious and inherent.
- 13. At the time of participating in the Event and/or in using the Suppliers' facilities, I will not to any degree be under the influence of alcohol or illicit drugs.
- 14.
